## Guide Dogs and Assistance Dogs at Best Day Ever Wedding Venues

We kindly ask that you let us know in advance, if you or any of your wedding guests are visiting any of our Best Day Ever Venues with an assistance dog or a guide dog.

We politely request that the dog wears a working coat or lead and that you carry your registration card or AD(UK) Identification Book with you. Our expectation is that your assistance dog will have formal identification in the form of:

- ID tags on the dog's collar
- a harness
- an organisation-specific branded dog jacket or harness
- a lead slip

People who have an assistance dog from an ADUK member organisation will also have a yellow ADUK branded Identification Booklet. This Booklet has been designed to support assistance dog owners with access to facilities and services.



We anticipate that in line with The Equality and Human Rights Commission's definition, your assistance dog:

- is highly trained
- will not wander freely around the premises
- will sit or lie quietly on the floor next to its owner
- is unlikely to foul in a public place
- be instantly recognisable by the harness or identifying dog jacket they wear.
